

Marshall Scholarships Act 1959

1959 CHAPTER 3 8 and 9 Eliz 2

An Act to increase the number of Marshall scholarships which may be provided in each year. [17th December 1959]

1 Increase in maximum number of Marshall scholarships.

- (1) Section one of the MI Marshall Aid Commemoration Act 1953, shall have effect with the substitution for the reference to twelve scholarships of a reference to twenty-four or such greater number as Her Majesty may by Order in Council from time to time determine.
- (2) Any Order in Council under this section shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
