41 Special provisions as to Scotland.

(1) For the purpose of providing institutions for the treatment of tuberculosis or any such other disease as the [F4Secretary of State], with the approval of the Treasury, may appoint, a county council in Scotland shall have power to borrow . . . F5 such sums as may be required, and shall have power to acquire, purchase, or take on lease any land; [F6 and may be authorised by the Secretary of State to purchase land compulsorily for the said purpose.]
