If the occupier of a factory <sup>F4</sup>. . . knowingly allows a woman to be employed therein within four weeks after she has given birth to a child, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F5</sup>level 1 on the standard scale]. <sup>F6</sup>...
