1838 CHAPTER 43 1 and 2 Vict

LVIII Assignments of Gales to be entered in Gaveller's Books.

A minute or docquet of all transfers to be made after the passing of this Act of all gales within the said Hundred, including all such as are now existing, or hereafter to be ascertained in the said Award, or hereafter to be granted, and of all transfers of leases of quarries hereafter to be granted, shall be entered in the Books of the Gaveller or Deputy Gaveller for the time being within three calendar months after the making thereof respectively, who shall thereupon indorse and sign a memorandum of such entry, and the date thereof, on such transfer, or, in the case of an assignment of a gale granted after the passing of this Act, on the original certificate of the grant thereof; and a fee of [$^{F1}12^{1/2}p$] shall be paid for every such entry, or in default thereof such transfers shall be void.
