



# Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 27 10 and 11 Vict

*Harbour, dock, and pier master*

**62 Penalty for wilfully cutting moorings. U.K.**

Every person, other than the harbour master, who shall wilfully cut, break, or destroy the mooring or fastening of any vessel lying in the harbour or dock, or at or near the pier, shall for every such offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding [<sup>F1</sup>level 1 on the standard scale].
