Nuisances

29	Penalty on drunken persons, &c. guilty of riotous or indecent behaviour.
	or indecent behaviour in any police office or any police station house, within the
	limits of the special Act, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty shillings for
	every such offence, or, in the discretion of the justice before whom he is convicted, to
	imprisonment for a period not exceeding seven days.
