1876 CHAPTER 36 39 and 40 Vict

AS TO THE ISLE OF MAN

277 Isle of Man deemed part of United Kingdom for Customs purposes.

The Isle of Man shall be deemed and taken to be part of the United Kingdom for all the purposes of the Customs Acts; but nothing herein contained shall prejudice or affect, or be construed in any way, directly or indirectly, to prejudice or affect, any of the rights or privileges legally exercised or enjoyed by the said isle at the time of the passing of this Act.
