PENSION SCALE

Pensions and Gratuities to Constables

- (3) The pension to a constable on retirement who is wholly incapacitated by infirmity of mind or body occasioned in the execution of his duty without his own default shall, in the case of accidental injury, be according to the following scale, that is to say,
 - (a) if he has completed not more than ten years service, an annual sum not more than fifteen fiftieths of his annual pay; and
 - (b) if he has completed more than ten and not more than fifteen years service, an anal sum not more than twenty fiftieths of his annual pay; [FI and]
 - [F1(c) if he has completed more than fifteen years service, an annual sum not more than his annual pay:]

[F1Provided that if he has completed fifteen years service the pension shall not be less than the sum to which he is entitled under article one of this schedule.]
