PART I

PROVISION OF SMALL HOLDINGS BY COUNTY COUNCILS

12 Extensions of provisions of 45 & 46 Vict. c. 38.

Where the person having the powers of a tenant for life within themeaning of the Settled Land Act, 1882, sells, exchanges, or leases, any settled land to a county council for the purposes of this Act, such sale, exchange, or lease may be made at such a price, or for suchconsideration, or at such rent as, having regard to the said purposes and to all the circumstances of the case, is the best that can be reasonably obtained.

Modifications etc. (not altering text)
