The National Enterprise Board (Dissolution) Order 1996

The Secretary of State, having consulted the National Enterprise Board (“the Board”) and British Technology Group Limited (“the successor company”)(**1**) and being satisfied that nothing further remains to be done by the Board under Schedule 3 to the British Technology Group Act 1991(**2**), in exercise of his powers under subsection (2) of section 11 of that Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the National Enterprise Board (Dissolution) Order 1996.
2. The Board shall be dissolved on 1st July 1996.
