# EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES EDUCATION, SCOTLAND

The Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1998

*Made* - - - - *3rd September 1998* 

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46(4) of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998(1), the Secretary of State for Education and Employment hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and interpretation**

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1998.

(2) In this Order-

"the 1988 Act" means the Education Reform Act 1988(2); and

"the 1998 Act" means the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998.

#### **Provisions coming into force**

2. The following provisions of the 1998 Act shall come into force on 1st October 1998:

section 1(1), to the extent that it defines the "the Council" but not so as to establish the General Teaching Council for England as a body;

section 1(2) to (10); section 8; section 16; section 17; section 19(1) to (8) and 10(b) and (c); section 20; section 21; section 34;

- paragraph 9; and

in Schedule 4, the repeal of-

3. Section 19(9) and (10)(a) of the 1998 Act shall come into force on 1st April 1999.
