**The West Dunbartonshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1998**

*Made* - - - - - *25th November 1998*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st January 1998*

Whereas under section 17(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(1), as read with Schedule 5 to that Act(2), the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland on 26th May 1998 submitted to the Secretary of State a report on a review together with its proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the area of West Dunbartonshire Council;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 17(2) and 233(3) of, and Schedule 5 to, the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the West Dunbartonshire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 1st January 1999.

**Interpretation**

2. In the Schedule to this Order—

(a) a reference to—

(i) an electoral ward is a reference to that electoral ward as constituted in this Order; and

(ii) a road, footpath, railway line, river, burn or canal shall, where the context so admits, be construed as a reference to the centre line of the feature concerned; and

(b) the following abbreviations are used:—

“EW” for electoral ward;

“NG Ref” for National Grid Reference as published on Ordnance Survey Maps.

**Electoral arrangements**

3. The area of West Dunbartonshire Council shall be divided into 22 wards, having the names, contents and boundaries set forth in the Schedule to this Order.

Commencing at the junction of the Clydebank to Drumchapel Railway Line on Kilbowie Road NG Ref NS 4981 7083; then southwestward along the said road to where it crosses the Forth and Clyde Canal; then eastward along the said canal to the western boundary of EW 1; then generally southward along the said EW boundary to the River Clyde NG Ref NS 4988 6914; then generally northwestward along the said river to the point of confluence with the Duntocher Burn at NG Ref NS 4726 7100; then northeastward to and along the said burn to the junction with Dumbarton Road; then southeastward along Dumbarton Road to the junction with Scott Street; then northeastward along Scott Street to the junction with the Clydebank to Drumchapel Railway Line; then generally southeastward along the said railway line to the junction with Duntocher Road; then generally southwestward along Duntocher Road to Dumbarton Road; then southeastward along the said road to the point where it crosses the Forth and Clyde Canal; then northeastward and southeastward along the said canal to the junction with Boquhanran Road; then generally northward and northeastward along Boquhanran Road to the junction with the Clydebank to Drumchapel Railway Line NG Ref NS 4901 7112; then generally eastward along the said railway line to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 3 Mountblow**

Commencing at the junction of Great Western Road A82 and Mountblow Road NG Ref NS 4800 7277; then generally southward along Mountblow Road to the junction with Perth Crescent; then generally westward along Perth Crescent to the junction with Kimberley Street; then generally southward along Kimberley Street to NG Ref NS 4802 7222; then generally westward to NG Ref NS 4792 7221 on Perth Crescent, then generally southeastward along Perth Crescent to the junction with Melbourne Avenue; then generally southeastward along Melbourne Avenue to the western curtilage of No 29 Melbourne Avenue; then generally southwestward along the said curtilage of No 29 Melbourne Avenue; then generally northwestward and southwestward to Salisbury Place; then southeastward along Salisbury Place to the junction with the rear access to Salisbury Place; then southeastward along the said access and its continuation in a straight line to Mountblow Road; then generally southwestward along Mountblow Road to the junction with Dumbarton Road; then southeastward along Dumbarton Road to the western boundary of EW 2; then generally southwestward along the said EW boundary to the River Clyde NG Ref NS 4726 7100; then generally northwestward along the said river to NG Ref NS 4691 7145; then generally eastward to the channel

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entering the River Clyde at NG Ref NS 4698 7148; then generally northeastward along the said channel to the Forth and Clyde Canal; then southeastward along the said canal to a point in line with the rear curtilages of Nos 201 to 203 Durban Avenue; then northeastward to and along the said rear curtilages of Nos 205 to 209 Durban Avenue and their prolongation in a straight line to the centre of the roundabout at the junction of Dumbarton Road and Western Isles Road NG Ref NS 4740 7197; then generally northwestward along Old Dalnottar Road to Harris Road; then northeastward along Harris Road to Lewis Crescent; then northward along Lewis Crescent to a point in line with the rear curtilage of No 2 Harris Drive; then northwestward to and along the rear curtilages of Nos 2 to 28 Harris Drive to the rear curtilage of No 9 Dalnottar Gardens; then northeastward along the rear curtilages of Nos 9 to 7 Dalnottar Gardens to the eastern curtilage of No 12 Dalnottar Drive; then northeastward along the said curtilage and continuing northeastward to and along the eastern curtilage of No 11 Dalnottar Drive to the rear curtilage of No 8 Lewis Place; then northeastward along the rear curtilages of Nos 8 to 6 Lewis Place; then northeastward in a straight line to the Old Kilpatrick to Drumchapel Railway Line; then generally northwestward along the said railway line to NG Ref NS 4698 7265; then generally northward and northeastward along a path to the junction with Great Western Road A82; then generally eastward along the said road to the point of commencement.

### **Ward 7 Kilbowie West**

Commencing at the junction of Kilbowie Road and the Clydebank to Drumchapel Railway Line NG Ref NS 4981 7083; then generally westward along the said railway line to the eastern boundary of EW 4; then generally northeastward along the said EW boundary to the western boundary of EW 6; then generally southeastward and southward along the western boundaries of EW 6 and EW 5 to the point of commencement.

### **Ward 8 Faifley**

Commencing at the centre of the Lomond Road/Luss Road Roundabout NG Ref NS 3863 8159; then generally southward along Luss Road to the junction with Argyll Street; then generally northeastward along Argyll Street to the junction with the Balloch to Dumbarton railway line at NG Ref NS 3915 8126; then generally northward along the said railway line to the junction with Lomond Road; then generally eastward along Lomond Road to the junction with the centre line of the River Leven at NG Ref NS 3916 8174; then generally southward along the said river to NG Ref NS 3935 8028; then generally westward in a straight line to the centre of the Balloch to Dumbarton railway line at NG Ref NS 3931 8028; then generally southward along the said railway to where it meets the northern boundary of EW 17 at NG Ref NS 3932 7999; then generally westward, southward, westward, northward, westward, southward and westward along the said EW boundary to the junction with the western boundary of West Dunbartonshire Council at NG Ref NS 3690 7966; then generally northwestward along the said council boundary to NG Ref NS 3560 8165; then generally eastward along a forestry track to NG Ref NS 3621 8174; then generally northwestward to and along a field boundary to NG Ref NS 3610 8193; then generally eastward along a field boundary and its prolongation to the junction with the A82(T) at NG Ref NS 3791 8198; then generally southeastward to the A82(T)/Lomond Road Roundabout; then generally eastward to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 19 Balloch**

Commencing at the junction of Lomond Road and the centre line of the River Leven on the northern boundary of EW 18 at NG Ref NS 3916 8174; then generally westward, southward, southwestward, northward, westward, northward and westward along the said EW boundary to where it meets the western boundary of West Dunbartonshire Council at NG Ref NS 3560 8165; then generally northwestward and northeastward along the said council boundary to a point in Loch Lomond at NG Ref NS 3793 8388; then generally southeastward along the prolongation of the River Leven and along the River Leven to NG Ref NS 3885 8237; then generally eastward in a straight line to NG Ref NS 3897 8242; then generally northward, eastward and southward along the Moss o' Balloch

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Plantations to NG Ref NS 3924 8261; then northeastward in a straight line to the western boundary of the Mollanbowie Housing Estate at NG Ref NS 3932 8267; then generally northward and eastward along the western and northern boundaries of the said estate to the junction of Mollanbowie Road NG Ref NS 3959 8279; then generally southward and southeastward along Mollanbowie Road to NG Ref NS 3987 8227; then generally northward and eastward along the rear curtilages of Mossburn Avenue to the junction with Stirling Road A811; then generally southwestward along Stirling Road to the junction with Drymen Road; then generally southwestward along Drymen Road to the junction with Mollanbowie Road; then northwestward along Mollanbowie Road to a point opposite the rear curtilage of the property known as Fiveways; then southwestward to and along the said curtilage and continuing along the rear curtilages of the properties lying to the north of Drymen Road to Lawrence Drive; then in a straight line southwestward to and along the northern curtilage of No 1 Lawrence Drive to the rear curtilage of the property known as Croftlea; then southwestward along the said curtilage and continuing along the rear curtilages of the properties lying to the north of Drymen Road to the western curtilage of the property known as Woodside; then southeastward along the said curtilage to Drymen Road; then southwestward along Drymen Road to the junction with Carrochan Road; then generally southeastward along Carrochan Road to the junction with Carrochan Burn NG Ref NS 3960 8180; then generally southwestward along the said burn to its confluence with the River Leven; then generally northward along the said river to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 20 Haldane/Kilmaronock/Jamestown**

Commencing at the confluence of the Carrochan Burn and the River Leven on the eastern boundary of EW 19 NG Ref NS 3942 8133; then generally northwestward along the said EW boundary to its junction with the northern boundary of West Dunbartonshire Council at NG Ref NS 3793 8388; then northwestward, northeastward and generally southeastward along the said council boundary to the northern boundary of EW 11 at NG Ref NS 4609 8154; then generally westward and southwestward along the said EW boundary to a field boundary at NG Ref NS 4318 8035; then northeastward in a straight line along the said field boundary to NG Ref NS 4323 8076; then northwestward along the line of a field boundary to the unnamed burn at NG Ref NS 4288 8168; then generally northeastward and northwestward along the said burn to the line of the dismantled railway line; then southwestward along the said railway line to the point it crosses the River Leven on the eastern boundary of EW 18; then northwestward along the said EW boundary to the point of commencement.

#### **Ward 21 Bonhill East**

Commencing at the junction of EWs 11 and 20 at NG Ref NS 4318 8034; then generally southwestward along the western boundary of EW 11 to the northern boundary of EW 14 NG Ref NS 4070 7901; then generally southwards along the said EW boundary to its junction with the Red Burn NG Ref NS 4036 7855; then generally westward along the said burn to the junction with the A813 Stirling Road; then generally northward along the said road to a point in line with a path leading to the Ladyton Community Centre; then eastward to and along the said path to the western curtilage of the Community Centre; then northward to and along the said curtilage to an unnamed road leading to Stirling Road; then generally northwestward along the said unnamed road to the southern boundary of Bonhill Quarry; then generally northeastward and northward along the southern and eastern boundaries of Bonhill Quarry (Disused) to NG Ref NS 3991 7969; then generally westward to NG Ref NS 3988 7969; then northward along a field boundary to NG Ref NS 3993 7989; then westward in a straight line to Northfield Road; then generally northward along Northfield Road and its prolongation to the junction with Auchencarroch Road; then generally northeastward along the said road to the junction with the Ruchetmoss Burn; then generally northwestward along the said burn to the junction with a disused railway line and the southern boundary of EW 20 at NG Ref NS 4032 8140; then generally northeastward and southeastward along the said EW boundary to the point of commencement.

## **Ward 22 Riverside**

Commencing at the junction of the River Leven and the disused railway line on the southern boundary of EW 20 NG Ref NS 3956 8122; then generally eastward along the said EW boundary to the western boundary of EW 21; then generally southward along the said EW boundary to the western boundary of EW 14; then generally southward and westward along the said EW boundary to the northern boundary of EW 15; then northwestward along the said EW boundary to the eastern boundary of EW 17; then generally northward along the said EW boundary to the point of commencement.

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### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect (with minor modifications of a drafting nature) to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland for the future electoral arrangements for the area of West Dunbartonshire Council. The proposals follow on the review of the whole of Scotland undertaken by the Commission in terms of Schedule 5 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973. The area of West Dunbartonshire Council is divided into 22 electoral wards as described in the Schedule to the Order. In terms of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994, the wards apply with effect from the ordinary election of councillors due to take place in May 1999.
