**The Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth
Disease) (Wales) (No.9) (Amendment) Regulations 2001**

Made - - - - *19th July 2001*

Coming into force - - *20th July 2001*

The National Assembly for Wales, being designated (1) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 (2) in relation to the Common Agricultural Policy of the European Community, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by that section, makes the following Regulations:

Title, application and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No. 9) (Amendment) Regulations 2001; they apply to Wales and come into force on 20th July 2001.

Amendment to the Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No. 9) Regulations 2001

2. Regulation 1(2) of the Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No. 9) Regulations 2001 (3) is amended by substituting the words “30th September 2001” for the words “20th July 2001”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations/Order)

These Regulations implement Commission Decision [2001/547/EC](#) amending for the sixth time Decision [2001/356/EC](#) concerning certain protection measures with regard to foot-and-mouth disease in the United Kingdom (O.J. L 195, 19.7.2001, p.61). The Regulations apply to only to Wales. They extend the expiry date of the Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No. 9) Regulations 2001 from 20th July to 30th September.
