## COMMISSION DECISION

#### of 4 December 1964

amending Article 1 of the Decision of 30 July 1964 on the institution of a special method of administrative co-operation for applying intra-Community treatment to the fishery catches of vessels of Member States

(64/718/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY,

Having regard to the provisions of the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular the first subparagraph of Article 10 (2) thereof;

Having regard to the Commission Decision of 30 July 19641 on the institution of a special method of administrative co-operation for applying intra-Community treatment to the fishery catches of vessels of Member States;

Whereas the use of the movement certificate (Form DD5) introduced by the above-mentioned Commission Decision is admissible, not only where processing of fishery catches on board vessels of Member States aims solely at their preservation but also where such processing does not result in the exclusion of those products from Chapter 3 of the Common Customs Tariff;

## HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### Article 1

Article 1 of the Decision of 30 July 1964 shall be amended to read as follows:

### 'Article 1

Within the framework of the administrative co-operation provided for in the

subparagraph of Article 10 (2) of the Treaty, a movement certificate (Form DD5) shall be introduced.

The purpose of that certificate shall be to establish that fishery catches of vessels of a Member State originate in that Member State within the meaning of Article 9 (2) of the Treaty even though they were landed in another Member State (hereinafter called "the Member State of introduction") either in the natural state or after a process carried out on board which does not result in their exclusion from Chapter 3 of the Common Customs Tariff, without previously passing through a port situated in the territory of the first Member State.'

# Article 2

Member States shall apply this Decision from 1 January 1965.

#### Article 3

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
