

COMMISSION DECISION

of 5 May 1976

specifying the extent to which applications for import licences lodged from 26 to 30 April 1976 for young bovine animals of highland breeds for fattening can be accepted

(76/474/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 568/76 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 21 (2) thereof,Whereas Article 2 (2) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 883/76 of 14 April 1976 on an amended system for the importation of certain young bovine animals of highland breeds for fattening while protective measures are in force ⁽³⁾, provided that the Commission shall decide, subject to an overall monthly limit of 10 000 head, the extent to which applications for import licences can be accepted;

Whereas the applications submitted during the period 26 to 30 April 1976 are less than the prescribed limit; whereas the applications for import licences submitted should therefore be accepted in full,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION :

Article 1

The applications for import licences submitted from 26 to 30 April 1976 pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 883/76 shall be accepted in full.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
