COMMISSION DECISION

of 10 June 1976

placing foot-and-mouth disease vaccine at the disposal of the FAO

(76/548/EEC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Decision 73/88/EEC of 26 March 1973 on action to protect Community livestock against certain foot-and-mouth diseases (1), as amended by the Commission Decision of 8 October 1973 (2), and in particular Article 5 thereof,

Whereas in view of the present health situation in the Community, vaccine from the Community stock can be placed at the disposal of the FAO in order to assist that organization in its campaign against foot-and-mouth disease in south-east Europe;

Whereas the measure provided for in this Decision is in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary Committee, HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

With effect from 1 June 1976, 150 000 doses of footand-mouth disease vaccine Asia 1, and 200 000 doses of foot-and-mouth disease vaccine A 22, shall be held at the disposal of the FAO as a contribution from the European Economic Community in the campaign against foot-and-mouth disease in south-east Europe.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
