

COMMISSION DECISION

of 15 June 1976

on the cancellation of the invitation to tender opened by Regulation (EEC) No 1222/76 for the supply of butteroil as food aid

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 559/76⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 6 (7) thereof,

Whereas, pursuant to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1222/76 of 24 May 1976 concerning the invitation to tender for the supply of butteroil as food aid to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan⁽³⁾, the French intervention agency has invited tenders for the manufacture and delivery of 1 000 metric tons of butteroil to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and divided into two lots of 500 metric tons;

Whereas Article 7 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2247/75 of 29 August 1975 concerning conditions for invitations to tender for the costs of manufacture and delivery of butteroil as food aid to certain developing countries and to the World Food Programme⁽⁴⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 578/76⁽⁵⁾, provides that in the light of the tenders received the maximum amount is to be fixed or the tendering procedure is to be cancelled;

Whereas, on the basis of the tenders received, the tendering procedure is to be cancelled;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The tendering procedure pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 1222/76 is cancelled.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the French Republic.
