COUNCIL DECISION

of 28 May 1980

appointing an alternate member of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers

(80/596/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community (1), and in particular Article 27 thereof,

Having regard to the Council Decision of 17 March 1980 appointing, for the period ending on 16 March 1982, members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers,

Whereas the Council decided on that occasion to appoint at a later date one person to fill an alternate member's seat allocated to a United Kingdom national in the trade union representatives category;

Having regard to the nomination submitted on 7 May 1980,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sole Article

Mr A. L. Sapper is hereby appointed an alternate mamber of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the remainder of the Committee's term of office, which runs until 16 March 1982.
