

COMMISSION DECISION

of 19 December 1995

**amending Decision 93/13/EEC laying down the procedures for veterinary checks
at Community border inspection posts on products from third countries**

(96/32/EC)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Community,Having regard to Council Directive 90/675/EEC of 10
December 1990 laying down the principles governing the
organization of veterinary checks on products entering
the Community from third countries ⁽¹⁾, as last amended
by the Act of Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden,
and in particular Article 14 (1) thereof,Whereas Commission Decision 93/13/EEC ⁽²⁾, as last
amended by Decision 94/305/EC ⁽³⁾, lays down certain
procedures for veterinary checks at Community border
inspection posts on products from third countries ;Whereas, the current rules applying to weight limits for
products which are contained in travellers' personal
luggage and intended for personal consumption must be
adjusted to take account of some specific situations as
regards fish caught for recreation in Norway or Russia and
introduced into Sweden and Finland ;Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in
accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary
Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION :

*Article 1*The following paragraph is added to Article 5 of Decision
93/13/EEC :

'4. However, for fish caught for recreation and
introduced into Finland or Sweden from Norway or
Russia in the personal luggage of travellers for direct
consumption by private individuals, the weight limit
provided for in paragraph 1 is put at a maximum of
15 kg or one fish of any weight.'

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
