COMMISSION DECISION

of 11 May 2001

amending Decision 2001/356/EC concerning certain protection measures with regard to foot-andmouth disease in the United Kingdom

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Directive 90/425/EEC of 26 June 1990 concerning veterinary and zootechnical checks applicable in intra-Community trade in certain live animals and products with a view to the completion of the internal market (1), as last amended by Directive 92/118/EEC (2), and in particular Article 10 thereof,

Having regard to Council Directive 89/662/EEC of 11 December 1989 concerning veterinary checks in intra-Community trade with a view to the completion of the internal market (3), as last amended by Directive 92/118/EEC, and in particular Article 9 thereof,

Whereas:

- Following the reports of outbreaks of foot-and-mouth (1) disease in the United Kingdom, the Commission adopted Decision 2001/356/EC concerning certain protection measures with regard to foot-and-mouth disease in the United Kingdom and repealing Decision 2001/ 172/EC (4).
- (2) Although the disease situation is improving, it appears necessary to prolong the measures provided for in Decision 2001/356/EC.

- The situation shall be reviewed at the meeting of the Standing Veterinary Committee scheduled for 12 June 2001 and the measures adapted where necessary.
- The measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

In Decision 2001/356/EC the date in Article 15 is replaced by '19 June 2001'.

Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
