THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 23(2) thereof,

Having regard to Council Joint Action 2002/921/CFSP of 25 November 2002 extending the mandate of the European Union Monitoring Mission⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 5(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) On 22 November 2004, the Council adopted Decision 2004/795/CFSP⁽²⁾ extending the mandate of Ms Maryse DAVIET as Head of Mission of the European Monitoring Mission (EUMM). This Decision expires on 31 December 2005.
- (2) On 21 November 2005, the Council adopted Joint Action 2005/807/CFSP extending and amending the mandate of the European Union Monitoring Mission (EUMM)⁽³⁾ until 31 December 2006.
- (3) The mandate of the Head of Mission of the EUMM should therefore also be extended,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The mandate of Ms Maryse DAVIET as Head of Mission of the EUMM is hereby extended until 31 December 2006.

Article 2

This Decision shall take effect on the date of its adoption.

Article 3

This Decision shall be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
