

Council Directive of 8 December 1969 on
control of Potato Wart Disease (69/464/EEC)

Article 5

1 The Member States shall provide that in the safety zone potatoes may be grown only if they are of a variety which is resistant to the races of *Synchytrium endobioticum* found on the contaminated plot.

2 A potato variety shall be regarded as being resistant to a particular race of *Synchytrium endobioticum* when it reacts to contamination by the pathogenic agent of that race in such a way that there is no danger of secondary infection.
