# I<sup>F1</sup>Article 2

## **Definitions**

For the purposes of this Directive, the definitions laid down in Article 2 of Directive 2000/60/EC and in Article 2 of Commission Directive 2009/90/EC of 31 July 2009 laying down, pursuant to Directive 2000/60/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, technical specifications for chemical analysis and monitoring of water status<sup>(1)</sup> shall apply.

In addition, the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) 'matrix' means a compartment of the aquatic environment, namely water, sediment or biota;
- (2) 'biota taxon' means a particular aquatic taxon within the taxonomic rank 'sub-phylum', 'class' or their equivalent.]
