### **CHAPTER VIII**

### TRANSITIONAL AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 29

#### Repeal

Directive 87/102/EEC shall be repealed [X1 with effect from 11 June 2010.]

### Article 30

#### **Transitional measures**

- 1 This Directive shall not apply to credit agreements existing on the date when the national implementing measures enter into force.
- However, Member States shall ensure that Articles 11, 12, 13 and 17, the second sentence of Article 18(1), and Article 18(2) are applied also to open-end credit agreements existing on the date when the national implementing measures enter into force.

# Article 31

## **Entry into force**

This Directive shall enter into force on the 20th day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Directive is addressed to the Member States.
