## REGULATION No 2/66/EURATOM OF THE COUNCIL

## of 28 February 1966

amending the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre employed in the Netherlands

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN ATOMIC ENERGY COMMUNITY,

5.3.66

Having regard to Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC)<sup>1</sup> on the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, and in particular the second paragraph of Article 4 and Articles 94 and 95 of those Conditions of Employment;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 11/65/Euratom<sup>2</sup> laying down the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre employed in the Netherlands, and in particular Article 13 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas it is for the Council, acting on a proposal from the Commission, to lay down, in the light of local practice, the conditions governing remuneration for establishment staff of the Joint Nuclear Research Centre at each place of employment, and the allowances, insurance, social security and all kinds of other related benefits to which such persons are entitled;

Whereas, in view of the changes in salaries of staff of the Reactor Centrum Nederland made in 1965, Article 3 of Regulation No 11/65/Euratom should be amended;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

The following shall be added to Article 3 of Regulation No 11/65/Euratom:

For the year 1965 a single allowance equal to 4% of the annual remuneration shall be granted. This allowance shall be calculated on the basic salary and the leave allowance and, where appropriate, on the rent allowance granted by law and the on-call allowance.

The single allowance shall be paid to a member of establishment staff in employment on 1 December 1965; anyone who has not on 31 December 1965 been employed as a member of establishment staff in the Netherlands for twelve months shall receive a single allowance calculated proportionately.'

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1965.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
