REGULATION (EEC) No 2112/69 OF THE COUNCIL

of 28 October 1969

amending Regulation No 213/67/EEC laying down the list of representative markets for pigmeat in the Community

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 121/67/EEC¹ of 13 June 1967 on the common organisation of the market in pigmeat, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1398/69,² and in particular Article 4 (5) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the list of the representative markets for pigmeat in the Community was established by Regulation No 213/67/EEC,³ as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1705/68⁴;

Whereas, for the purpose of broadening the scope of the market quotations in certain Member States and

of thus making them more representative, the list in the Annex to Regulation No 213/67/EEC should be amended;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Annex to this Regulation shall be substituted for the Annex to Regulation No 213/67/EEC.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November 1969.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
