REGULATION (EEC) No 649/72 OF THE COUNCIL

of 30 March 1972

fixing the aid for skimmed milk and skimmed milk powder for use as feed for the 1972/73 marketing year

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68¹ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1411/71,² and in particular the second subparagraph of Article 10 (2) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the second subparagraph of Article 10 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 provides that aid for skimmed milk and for skimmed milk powder produced within the Community and intended for use as feed shall be fixed each year for the following marketing year;

Whereas, for feed purposes, liquid skimmed milk and skimmed milk powder can be replaced by other nitrogenous substances; whereas these are generally less expensive in the Community than skimmed milk; whereas the aid provided for in Article 10 of Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 must consequently be fixed in such a way that liquid skimmed milk and skimmed milk powder can be used as feed;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

For the 1972/73 marketing year the aid shall be:

- (a) 1.65 units of account per 100 kilogrammes of skimmed milk,
- (b) 17.62 units of account per 100 kilogrammes of skimmed milk powder.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 April 1972.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
