

**REGULATION (EEC) No 1088/73 OF THE COMMISSION**

of 26 April 1973

**amending the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 370/73 fixing compensatory amounts for poultrymeat products other than chicks and slaughtered poultry, whole**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty <sup>(1)</sup> concerning the Accession of new Member States to the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community, signed at Brussels, on 22 January 1972;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 235/73 <sup>(2)</sup> of 31 January 1973 laying down general rules for the system of compensatory amounts for poultrymeat as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1053/73 <sup>(3)</sup> and in particular Article 8 (2) thereof;

Whereas the compensatory amounts applicable until 31 July 1973 for poultrymeat products, other than chicks and whole slaughtered poultry, were fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 370/73 <sup>(4)</sup> of 31 January 1973 and whereas the compensatory amounts for such products are derived from the compensatory amounts applicable for whole slaughtered poultry by using the coefficients fixed by Commission Regulation 199/67/EEC <sup>(5)</sup> of 28 June 1967, fixing the coefficients for calculating levies on derived poultrymeat products, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1087/73 <sup>(6)</sup>;

Whereas Council Regulation No 146/67/EEC <sup>(7)</sup> of 21 June 1967, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 988/73 <sup>(8)</sup>, laid down rules for calculating the levy and sluice-gate price for poultrymeat and whereas the last mentioned Regulation added the description '63 % ducks' to the Annexes to Regulation No 146/67/EEC for ducks which are plucked and drawn and without heads, feet, hearts, livers and gizzards and whereas halves and quarters of ducks under subheading 02.02 B II (a) 2 of the Common Customs Tariff are derived

from ducks falling within this description and whereas Regulation (EEC) No 1087/73 amended Regulation 199/67/EEC so as to provide for a coefficient of derivation for '63 % ducks';

Whereas the compensatory amounts in respect of halves or quarters of ducks specified in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 370/73 must in consequence be amended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for poultrymeat and eggs;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 370/73 the compensatory amounts shown against sub-heading 02.02 B II a) 2 for halves and quarters of ducks which appear in columns 3, 4 and 5 of the said Annex are hereby replaced by the following compensatory amounts:

*Article 2*

This regulation shall enter into force on 1 May 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
