

REGULATION (EEC) No 1889/74 OF THE COMMISSION

of 18 July 1974

definitively fixing the subsidies on colza and rape seed, provisionally fixed since 28 February 1974

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community ;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC ⁽¹⁾ of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1707/73 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 27 (4) thereof ;

the absence of a regulation fixing monthly increases in the target price and the basic intervention price for oil seeds for the 1974/75 marketing year ;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1686/74 ⁽²⁷⁾ of 27 June 1974 fixed, for the 1974/75 marketing year, the monthly increases in the target price and the intervention prices for oil seeds ; whereas following this fixation, the subsidies provisionally fixed for colza and rape seed must therefore be confirmed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The subsidies applicable to colza and rape seed in the event of advance fixing are, as from the date of entry into force shown therein, fixed definitely at the amounts set out in the table annexed to the Commission Regulation fixing the amount of the subsidy on oil seeds : Regulations (EEC) No 278/74, (EEC) No 291/74, (EEC) No 338/74, (EEC) No 399/74, (EEC) No 447/74, (EEC) No 506/74, (EEC) No 534/74, (EEC) No 562/74, (EEC) No 618/74, (EEC) No 650/74, (EEC) No 737/74, (EEC) No 819/74, (EEC) No 891/74, (EEC) No 940/74, (EEC) No 1049/74, (EEC) No 1105/74, (EEC) No 1181/74, (EEC) No 1252/74, (EEC) No 1316/74, (EEC) No 1374/74, (EEC) No 1403/74, (EEC) No 1437/74, (EEC) No 1496/74 and (EEC) No 1564/74.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 20 July 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
