

RÉGULATION (EEC) No 2515/74 OF THE COMMISSION

of 3 October 1974

amending Regulation (EEC) No 320/73 for the fourth time as regards the list of representative markets for adult bovine animals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 ⁽¹⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1855/74 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 10 (6) thereof;

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 320/73 ⁽³⁾ of 31 January 1973 on the determination of prices of calves and adult bovine animals on representative Community markets, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 646/74 ⁽⁴⁾, lays down the list of representative markets in each Member State for the various qualities of calves and adult bovine animals and for the meat of those animals;

Whereas following the closure of the Rotterdam market its business has been transferred to the Leiden market; whereas, in order to improve the recording of prices for adult bovine animals in the Netherlands, Leiden should be added to the list of representative markets for that country;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The list of representative markets for adult bovine animals set out in item H 1 of Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 320/73 is amended by the addition of 'Leiden'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply for the first time for the purpose of calculating the levies applicable with effect from 7 October 1974.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
