

**REGULATION (EEC) No 2097/75 OF THE COMMISSION**  
**of 8 August 1975**

**fixing the basic amount of the import levy on syrups and certain other sugar products**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3330/74<sup>(1)</sup> of 19 December 1974 on the common organization of the market in sugar, and in particular Article 15 (7) thereof;

Whereas the basic amount of the import levy on syrups and certain other sugar products was fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 1872/75<sup>(2)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2080/75<sup>(3)</sup>;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 1872/75 to the information at present available to the Commis-

sion that the basic amount of the levy at present in force should be altered as shown in this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The basic amount of the import levy on the products listed in Article 1 (1) d) of Regulation (EEC) No 3330/74 is hereby fixed, per 100 kilogrammes of product, at 0 unit of account per percentage point of sucrose content.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 9 August 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
