

REGULATION (EEC) No 2116/75 OF THE COMMISSION
of 12 August 1975

amending Regulation (EEC) No 2179/74 by postponing until 31 August 1975 the final date for the delivery of alcohol obtained from the compulsory distillation of the by-products of wine-making

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Regulation (EEC) No 816/70⁽¹⁾ of 28 April 1970 laying down additional provisions for the common organization of the market in wine, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 678/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 24 (4) thereof;

Whereas, to enable all producers to distil the by-products of wine-making, as required under Article 24 of Regulation (EEC) No 816/70, it is appropriate to replace the date 15 August 1975 in Article 5 of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2179/74⁽³⁾ of 20 August 1974 laying down in respect of the 1974/75 wine-growing year detailed rules for applying the obligation to distil the by-products of wine-making and

repealing Regulation (EEC) No 2069/73 by 31 August 1975;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the Opinion of the Management Committee for Wine,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 5 of Regulation (EEC) No 2179/74 the date '15 August 1975' is replaced by '31 August 1975'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
