

REGULATION (EEC) No 3241/75 OF THE COMMISSION
of 11 December 1975

amending Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 so as to discontinue the EXIM arrangements established as protective measures in respect of beef and veal

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68⁽¹⁾ of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1855/74⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 21 (2) thereof;

Whereas the arrangements established by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75⁽³⁾ of 23 April 1975 on the issue by way of protective measures of import licences for certain beef and veal products (EXIM), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3170/75⁽⁴⁾, are shortly to be replaced by other import arrangements, thus continuing the policy of relaxing the protective measures in this sector with a view to the gradual restoration of normal trading arrangements; whereas traders should therefore be warned of their last opportunity to obtain import licences under the present arrangements,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 4 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 is amended by the addition of a further subparagraph as follows:

‘No licence applications may be lodged in or after the month of January 1976’.

Article 2

The first subparagraph of Article 5 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 1090/75 is amended by the addition of the following sentence:

‘However, in the month of December 1975 such first licence shall be issued on 22 December’.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 12 December 1975.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
