## REGULATION (EEC) No 667/75 OF THE COUNCIL

## of 4 March 1975

# amending Regulation (EEC) No 1127/74 fixing, for the 1974/1975 marketing year, the monthly price increases for cereals, wheat and rye flour and wheat groats and meal

### THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 120/67/ EEC (<sup>1</sup>) of 13 June 1967 on the common organization of the market in cereals, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 665/75 (<sup>2</sup>), and in particular Article 6 (2) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas it was decided in Regulation (EEC) No 665/75 that as from 1 August 1975 the beginning of the marketing year for maize and sorghum would not be fixed at a different date from that for the other cereals; whereas 31 July 1975 should be fixed as the time limit for the application of the monthly increases to be applied to maize shown in Article 2

of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1127/74 (<sup>3</sup>) of 29 April 1974 fixing, for the 1974/75 marketing year, the monthly price increases for cereals, wheat and rye flour and wheat groats and meal, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1998/74 (<sup>4</sup>); whereas the same provisions should be applied to sorghum in accordance with Article 3 of the same Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Sole Article

The monthly increases provided for in Articles 2 and 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1127/74 for maize and sorghum shown under August and September 1975 are hereby deleted.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
