

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 3158/76
of 21 December 1976

on the supply of butteroil as emergency food aid for Lebanon pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 695/76

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 694/76 of 25 March 1976 laying down general rules for the supply of milk fats as food aid to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1976 food-aid programme⁽¹⁾, and in particular Articles 3 and 8 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 695/76 of 25 March 1976 on the supply of milk fats to certain developing countries and international organizations under the 1976 food-aid programme⁽²⁾ provides for a reserve of 3 640 metric tons butteroil;

Whereas the Lebanese Republic has requested food aid in the form of oils and fats; whereas its needs warrant food aid from the Community; whereas, in

view of the situation in Lebanon, the Community should bear the costs of transport to the frontier of that country,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Of the 3 640 metric tons of butteroil provided for as a reserve by Regulation (EEC) No 695/76, 1 240 metric tons shall be allocated to Lebanon.

Article 2

The Community shall bear the costs of transport to the frontier of the country of destination.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
