## COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1046/78

of 19 May 1978

extending for the 1978/79 marketing year the detailed rules of application for the granting of a slaughter premium for producers of bovine animals provided for by Regulation (EEC) No 926/77

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 870/77 of 26 April 1977 authorizing Member States to grant a premium on the slaughter of certain adult bovine animals for slaughtering during the 1977/78 marketing year (1), and in particular Article 4 thereof,

Whereas Article 1 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 996/78 of 12 May 1978 continuing for the 1978/79 marketing year the premium for the slaughter of certain adult bovine animals provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 870/77 (²) provides for arrangements laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 870/77 to be extended for the 1978/79 marketing year;

Whereas, consequently, it seems appropriate to provide for the extension, for the 1978/79 marketing year, of the arrangements laid down in Commission Regulation (EEC) No 926/77 of 29 April 1977 laying down detailed rules for the granting of a slaughter

premium for producers of bovine animals during the 1977/78 marketing year (3);

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

In Articles 2 and 8 of Regulation (EEC) No 926/77, the expression '1977/78 marketing year' is in each case replaced by the expression '1978/79 marketing year'.

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 22 May 1978.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
