

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1473/79**  
**of 13 July 1979**  
**correcting Regulation (EEC) No 1367/79 fixing the monetary compensatory**  
**amounts**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN  
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European  
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No  
974/71 of 12 May 1971 on certain measures of  
conjunctural policy to be taken in agriculture  
following the temporary widening of the margins of  
fluctuation for the currencies of certain Member  
States<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No  
987/79<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Whereas the monetary compensatory amounts  
provided for in Regulation (EEC) No 974/71 were  
fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1367/79  
of 29 June 1979<sup>(3)</sup>;

Whereas a check has revealed errors in the Annex to  
that Regulation; whereas the necessary corrections

comply with the principles laid down in the text  
submitted for opinion to the management committee  
concerned at the time when the Commission adopted  
Regulation (EEC) No 1367/79,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

In Part 7 of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1367/79  
the amount '5,20' under subheading 17.01 A is  
replaced by '6,20'.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 14 July  
1979.

Where any party concerned so requests, it shall apply  
with effect from 1 July 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member  
States.
