

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3471/80

of 30 December 1980

amending Regulation (EEC) No 2608/80 laying down detailed rules implementing Regulation (EEC) No 2528/80 laying down special measures in respect of olive oil producer organizations for the 1980/81 marketing year, as a result of Greek accession

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Greece ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 146 thereof,Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2608/80 ⁽²⁾ includes the criteria for incorporation of olive oil producer organizations for the producer Member States; whereas the said Regulation should be supplemented to take account of Greek accession,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following text is hereby added to Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 2608/80:

— if incorporated on mainland Greece or on the islands of Crete, Rhodes, Mytilene, Corfu, Euboea, comprise at least 1 000 producers or a number of members who have over the past three olive oil marketing years together achieved an average total production of at least 500 tonnes per year;

— if incorporated in Greece at a place other than those mentioned in the preceding paragraph, comprise at least 600 producers or a number of members who have over the past three olive oil marketing years together achieved an average total production of at least 300 tonnes per year.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1981.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
