

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 287/89

of 3 February 1989

suspending Regulation (EEC) No 732/78 on detailed rules for the sale to the armed forces of Member States of beef held by the intervention agencies

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of the Council of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 4132/88⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (3) thereof,

Whereas, by Regulation (EEC) No 732/78⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1809/87⁽⁴⁾, the Commission made provision for sales of beef to the armed forces in the framework of special disposal measures; whereas, in view of the current situation of intervention stocks, the said Regulation should be suspended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 732/78 is hereby suspended.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
