

## ANNEX V

### WASTE SUBJECT TO THE EXPORT PROHIBITION IN ARTICLE 36

#### Part 1<sup>(1)</sup>

##### List A (Annex VIII to the Basel Convention)

- A3 WASTES CONTAINING PRINCIPALLY ORGANIC CONSTITUENTS, WHICH MAY CONTAIN METALS AND INORGANIC MATERIALS
- A3180 Wastes, substances and articles containing, consisting of or contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB), polychlorinated terphenyl (PCT), polychlorinated naphthalene (PCN) or polybrominated biphenyl (PBB), or any other polybrominated analogues of these compounds, at a concentration level of 50 mg/kg or more<sup>(2)</sup>

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**Changes to legislation:** There are currently no known outstanding effects for the Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council, Division A3180. (See end of Document for details)

- (2) The 50 mg/kg level is considered to be an internationally practical level for all wastes. However, many individual countries have established lower regulatory levels (e.g. 20 mg/kg) for specific wastes.
