65 Guidance about integrated family support teams

In exercising their functions under this Part, the following bodies must have regard to any guidance given from time to time by the Welsh Ministers—

- (a) a local authority;
- (b) a Local Health Board;
- (c) an integrated family support team;
- (d) an integrated family support board.
