6 Submission of draft strategy to Welsh Ministers

- (1) Each strategy must be submitted in draft to the Welsh Ministers by—
 - (a) the responsible authority, if there is only one responsible authority;
 - (b) the lead authority, if there is more than one responsible authority (or, where there is no lead authority, the responsible authorities acting together).
- (2) The Welsh Ministers must—
 - (a) inform the responsible authority or authorities that they are satisfied that the draft strategy complies with the requirements imposed by or under this Measure, or
 - (b) if they are not so satisfied, give the responsible authority or authorities such direction as the Welsh Ministers think fit for the purpose of ensuring that the strategy does comply with those requirements.
- (3) The responsible authority or authorities must not publish a strategy unless—
 - (a) subsection (2)(a), or
 - (b) if the Welsh Ministers have given a direction under subsection (2)(b), that direction, has been complied with.
- (4) The Welsh Ministers may by regulations make provision as to how and when the requirements of this section must be complied with.
