#### Introductory

#### Expressions used in connection with enforcement

**131.**—(1) For the purposes of this Act—

- (a) carrying out development without the planning permission required; or
- (b) failing to comply with any condition or limitation subject to which planning permission has been granted,

constitutes a breach of planning control.

- (2) For the purposes of this Act—
  - (a) the issue of an enforcement notice; or
  - (b) the service of a breach of condition notice,

constitutes taking enforcement action.
