

Allowances to Members of the Assembly (Repeal) Act (Northern Ireland) 2011

2011 CHAPTER 8

An Act to repeal the Allowances to Members of the Assembly Act (Northern Ireland) 2000. [10th February 2011]

BE IT ENACTED by being passed by the Northern Ireland Assembly and assented to by Her Majesty as follows:

Repeals

- 1.—(1) The Allowances to Members of the Assembly Act (Northern Ireland) 2000 (c. 3) is repealed.
- (2) The entry relating to the Northern Ireland Assembly Commission in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Statutory Rules (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 (NI 12) is repealed.

Commencement

2 This Act comes into operation on Royal Assent.

Short title

3 This Act may be cited as the Allowances to Members of the Assembly (Repeal) Act (Northern Ireland) 2011.
