## Abolition of scandalising the judiciary as form of contempt of court

**12.**—(1) Scandalising the judiciary (also referred to as scandalising the court or scandalising judges) is abolished as a form of contempt of court under the common law.

(2) That abolition does not prevent proceedings for contempt of court being brought against a person for conduct that immediately before that abolition would have constituted both scandalising the judiciary and some other form of contempt of court. **Status:** Point in time view as at 26/04/2013.
