The Department of Justice makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 14(7) of the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2016⁽¹⁾.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2016 (Relevant Benefits) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 00th July 2021.

Amendment of the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2016: relevant benefits

2. In section 14 of the Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 2016 (application for deduction from benefits), in sub section (3), before paragraph (a), insert—

“(za) universal credit;”.
