## The Appropriation (No. 3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973

#### Present.

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 (3) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972 (a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

#### Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 and shall come into operation forthwith.

#### Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (b) shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

# Issue out of Consolidated Fund of moneys for services in Northern Ireland

3. The Ministry of Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Fund, and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1974, the sum of thirty-one million, two hundred and ninety-one thousand, four hundred pounds.

## Power for the Ministry of Finance to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Ministry of Finance may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole sixteen million pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1974.

Appropriation of grants

5. The sum granted by this Order out of the Consolidated Fund towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty is appropriated for the several services and purposes expressed in the Schedule.

In addition to the sum granted as aforesaid out of the Consolidated Fund, the sums specified in the third column of the Schedule may be applied as appropriations in aid of the grants for the services in connection with which such sums are specified; and the sums already authorised to be appropriated in aid shall be decreased by the sum specified in the fourth column of the Schedule for the service in connection with which such sum is specified.
