Financial Provisions (Northern Ireland) Order 1976

Title and Commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Financial Provisions (Northern Ireland) Order 1976.
(2) *Commencement*

Interpretation

2.—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

(2) In this Order the expression “statutory provision” has the meaning assigned to it by section 1(f) of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954.

^[F2(2)] No order shall be made under paragraph (1) unless a draft of the order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Assembly.^{F2]}
