## Treatment of Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1976

### PART II

#### DISCHARGE FROM PRISON, ETC.

##### Appeals

4. Where under Article 3(1) [<sup>F1</sup> a magistrates'] court orders that a person be returned to prison or to a young offenders centre, that person shall have the like right of appeal against that order as if—

- (a) the court had immediately before making it convicted him; and
- (b) the order were a sentence passed upon that conviction.

[<sup>F2</sup> and where under Article 3(1) or (5) the Crown Court orders that a person be returned to prison or to a young offenders centre, that person may appeal against that order in accordance with section 9 of the Criminal Appeal (Northern Ireland) Act 1980 .]
