PROVISIONS FOR USE OF BLOOD TESTS IN DETERMINING PATERNITY

Penalty for personating another, etc., for purpose of providing blood sample

- 12. If, for the purpose of providing $a[^{F1}$ bodily sample] for a test required to give effect to a direction under Article 8, any person personates another, or proffers a child knowing that it is not the child named in the direction, he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable—
 - (a) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to a fine, or to both;
 - (b) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding [F2 level 5 on the standard scale].
